## THE FOLLOWING NEEDS TO BE DONE ON ALL NEW SERVICES WITHIN THE PENDLETON COUNTY WATER DISTRICT SERVICE AREA IN ORDER TO HAVE THE WATER TURNED ON:

- 1. At least 30" cover on service line
- 2. At least 200 PSI AWWA approved pipe
- 3. Shut off valve installed somewhere on your line
- 4. Install a check valve on your line
- 5. Install a pressure regulator
- 6. If you install any type of hydrant on your service line, you must install a dual check valve in front of that hydrant.
- 7. Your cistern must be unhooked before your water can be turned on. (Cistern water and county water must be totally separate. Outside spickets on cisterns are allowable.)
- 8. You will need to provide us with a copy of your plumbing permit or farm exemption form.
- 9. A \$75 deposit is required for all new customers.
